Books:

The Keys to Success piano studio utilizes the Faber Piano Adventures method for 1st-6th graders, and Alfred's Music for Little Mozarts piano lesson curriculum for Pre-K and Kindergarteners. These exceptional, pedagogical methods incorporate elements such as theory, performance, technique, sight reading, and aural skills. Along with these methods, supplementary materials will be used to enhance each student's musical experience. Creative activities will be incorporated into each student's weekly piano lesson to enhance the material being presented and engage visual, aural, verbal and kinesthetic learners. Students already utilizing a piano curriculum may continue using the books that they have been working in. New students will be provided with links to order the appropriate materials.

Pricing:

Pre-K Piano Exploration rates are as follows:
